



OFFICIAL STATEMENT

Support for Upholding the Principles of the UN Charter and UN General Assembly Resolutions in Resolving the Russia-Ukraine Conflict

Russia's invasion of Ukraine since February 24, 2022 has resulted in hundreds of civilian deaths, thousands injured, millions of people displaced, destruction of infrastructure as well as threatened regional and global political and economic security and stability.

In view of this crisis, The Habibie Center, as an independent think tank that promotes democracy and human rights takes the following standpoints:

1. The Habibie Center emphasizes the importance of respect for the United Nations Charter, particularly the respect for a state's sovereignty and territorial integrity, and the rejection of the use of violence in resolving disputes.
2. The Habibie Center condemns the Russian invasion of Ukraine which has violated the UN Charter articles 1 & 2, caused many deaths and injuries, damaged infrastructure, and disrupted global stability.
3. The Habibie Center supports all actions and steps, including the Indonesian Government's sponsorship of the UN General Assembly Resolution that demands Russia to cease its attacks and withdraw its troops from Ukraine.
4. The Habibie Center encourages the Government of Indonesia and ASEAN to play an active role at regional and global levels to stop the war in Ukraine by promoting peaceful dialogues and providing humanitarian assistance to the victims of war.
